#### Call to Order

Sean Davis brought the meeting to order at 10:30 a.m.

#### Introductions

#### Approval of Board Minutes from December 4, 2018

Motion to approve the minutes by Chief Mike Harris. Approved unanimously.

#### **New Business**

#### a. Chemical Facility Anti-Terrorism Standards (CFATS) update

Dr. Timothy Beinert gave a presentation to the group on the CFATS program. Dr. Beinert explained the program objectives and intent in detail. A .pdf of the slides was sent to the LEPC group.

#### b. National Weather Service - Pendleton

Vincent Papol introduced himself and briefed the LEPC on the current weather status as it pertains to the wild fire season. Mr. Papol also discusses what resources/capabilities NWS can provide during emergencies. Additionally, Mr. Papol gave examples of what NWS can provide as a training resource for plume modelling/projection.

#### c. America's Water Infrastructure Act 2018

Sean Davis shared the EPA document that recapped the main components of the amendments to the Emergency Planning and Community Right-to-Know Act - America's Water Infrastructure Act.

#### d. EPA Region X Inspections:

Sean Davis reported that the EPA Region X inspected 3 facilities in Franklin County, and asked if those facilities would share their experience with the group.
