This will allow us to meet the bid/RFA process, while expediting onboarding of a consultant. The intent will be to use Integrated Solutions Consulting for that project. Ken Woffenden asked if there is a potential that both the HMP and CWPP work will be happening in parallel. The Director stated that it will depend on how quickly the Federal/State governments get the funding contract to us. If they can turn it quickly, then yes, there is high probability that both be happening simultaneously. There we no other questions or discussion
