



C. New Business

- 1. Bret Tremble motioned to approve minutes from the June 6, 2024, meeting as presented. Mike Harris seconded the motion, no discussion, motion approved unanimously.
- 2. Mike Harris motioned to approve both the Benton and Franklin County ESF-10's as presented for their 2024 update and review. Eli Elisondo seconded the motion, no discussion, motion approved unanimously.
- Jordan Hanes presented on the Hazard Mitigation Plan process and LEPC involvement.
 We will be holding a couple of public meetings as well as a stakeholder meeting in October. Jordan will keep the LEPC informed on any updates and instructions on how to



participate in the planning process.

Walla Walla EM stated that they are roughly 75% through the HMP Process and are well underway on the CWPP update.

- 4. Chief John Knowles presented on the Downtown Walla Walla Gasoline Incident that started on 09/14/2023. Chief Knowles fielded questions about evacuations, response, monitoring and public information.
- 5. Sean Davis presented the flyer from WA Ecology on Spill Prevention, Preparedness, and Response Program. He encouraged LEPC members to review the flyer and the program and discussed how that program can help them with exercises, training etc.
- 6. The three LEPCs reported on the spills in the area over the last quarter Tidewater reported on their full-scale exercise that is happening on October 24, 2024, that is the culmination of their three-year exercise cycle. Pasco Airport is conducting their table top exercise on September 19, 2024. Multiple exercises for the Columbia and Snake River dams are happening in September and October.

Dan Brown and Steve Neal talked about Cybersecurity and Infrastructures Security Agency (CISA) capabilities and what they can provided. Dan Brown briefly discussed the cyberattack at Franklin County.
